Provincial Premises ID Change

For users in AB, BC, MB, NB, ON, PE, QC, YT, NS and NL, the premises registration process will change as per below:

1. Users are required to contact their provincial premises registrar to receive their provincially assigned premises identification number. Provincial registrar contact information can be found on the CRC – FAQs – Premises – “How can I get my premises number?”
2. After receiving the Provincial Premises ID, it can be added to the user's CLTS account using the same registration process as before, except with an added field for the provincial PID.

For users in SK, NU and NT, the premises registration process remains the same. Users are not required to provide a Provincial Premises ID.

Premises Registration

1. When registering premises within the provinces of AB, BC, MB, NB, ON, PE, QC, YT, NS and NL, the required field 'Provincial Prem ID' will appear.
2. The link “**How can I get a Provincial Premises ID?**” will appear beside the Provincial Premises ID field which will take the user to the FAQ document on the CRC.

3. The CLTS will verify if the provincial PID entered is valid or not during the registration. Users can not register a new premises using an invalid provincial PID.
4. After successfully registering a premises, users can use the provincial PID in searches and for event submissions.

Adding a Provincial PID to an existing CLTS premises

1. When editing premises within the provinces of AB, BC, MB, NB, ON, PE, QC, YT, NS and NL, the required field 'Provincial Prem ID' will appear.
2. The link "[How can I get a Provincial Premises ID?](#)" will appear beside the Provincial Premises ID field which will take the user to the FAQ document on the CRC.
3. Users can leave this field blank if they don't have a provincial PID yet and continue to use the CLTS PID.
4. Once a user enters the provincial PID, the CLTS will verify if it is valid or not. Users can not edit a premises using an invalid provincial PID.
