





Q: When should I use the premises (PID) number?

A: Premises Identification numbers (PID's) can be used when submitting information to the CLTS to attach an area of land to an animal event; such as showing the location of birth, movement or retirement. PID's are also used when transporting animals using manifests, export certificates and permits.

A registered premises is required to record movement in the CLTS. Each Canadian Province and Territory has specific guidelines for creating a premises identification number, please <u>click here</u> (or visit http://support.canadaid.ca/?p=1949) to see the information regarding premises registration in your province.
