Enhancements Made to the CLTS Database

Enhancement #1: USDA Tag Birthdate Certificate Validation Modification

Presently, in the birthdate certification function, a USDA tag can be added as a single tag. This update removes this option, so a birth certificate can no longer be generated for a USDA tag.

Enhancement #2: Introduction of Validation Rule for 840 Prefix Tags in CLTS

Presently, CLTS accepts USDA tags that begin with 840 and consist of fifteen digits. Moving forward, if they are followed by 202 as a suffix, they will be rejected. In the case of rejection, the error message should convey:

"This does not seem to be an approved USDA tag ID. Please tag the animal with an approved CCIA tag and utilize the newly applied tag ID for event submission."

An error message will display online if the event is submitted directly through the online method. For submissions via file upload or web services, the error will appear in the transaction and resemble the following:
